PROCESS OVERVIEW

The BGW team has developed an extensive process chart explaining the complete Building God's Way system. Walk through the process from the beginning of the preliminary design through the final building inspection. The discussion covers owner responsibilities and architect/general contractor duties over the timeline with a goal of clarifying your expectations.

ORGANIZATION TRAINING

This compelling session will train you to organize your staff/volunteers for a successful building campaign. Effective organizational structure is critical; this session will provide you the necessary road map for that success, including job descriptions for team leaders and committee members. The goal of this organizational structure is to increase outreach ministry opportunities, build relationships, honor God and grow your organization spiritually.

GIFT IN KIND PROCESS

A major element of the Building God's Way program is the Gift in Kind process. This valuable training session will teach you how to best utilize this system to further reduce your project costs. This session will also prepare your organization for its upcoming responsibilities in the Subcontractor Negotiation process. Subcontractor Negotiations are an essential element of GIK, and are supported heavily by BGW HQ and your regional BGW Builder. This segment of the BGW Institute is also taught by Dan Cook and may prove to be the most "profitable" reason for attending.

BGW | SUPPLY

Another valuable resource provided through the Building God's Way program is access to factory direct purchasing on building materials and furnishings. This informative session prepares you for your interaction with BGW | Supply. The speaker covers the BGWS purchasing process in detail, including product selection, construction coordination, scheduling, invoicing and shipping. This session is detailed and chock-full of information on a BGW program element that will be central during your construction project.

MINISTRY OF CONSTRUCTION

This session will show you opportunities that God places in the hearts of volunteers from any construction site. The Ministry of Construction is a means of sharing your faith in Jesus Christ with the unsaved workers on your project jobsites. This session will teach you how to build relationships by sharing our lives – this is the action which often opens a door to share our spiritual life as well.

The BGW | Forward in Faith session takes a look at the basic elements required for an effective capital campaign – preparing your organization for your upcoming fundraising effort.
